



PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS INFORMATION: “DOING YOUR PART”

1. **Complete 15 credit hours per long semester:** This requirement was put into place to promote a timely graduation. All Emerald Eagle Scholars are set on a four year path to graduation. By covering the average cost of 15 credit hours each semester, students are expected to earn 30 hours per year, making it easy to reach this goal. The program will only cover 8 long semesters, or 4 years.
2. **Maintain a minimum Cumulative GPA of 2.5:** The Emerald Eagle Scholars Program is for academically talented and motivated students. All Emerald Eagle Scholars should strive for success at UNT, surpassing the minimum requirement.
3. **Campus Connection:** We want the members of the program to get involved and be known on campus. In this packet you will find a Campus Connection Information sheet that outlines three paths. One must be completed each semester that you are indentified as an Emerald Eagle Scholar. By providing you with these three options early on, we are ensuring that you can plan accordingly in order to meet this requirement. More information will be presented on this during First Flight Week.
4. **Work Study Requirement:** As a first year Emerald Eagle Scholar, you will be required to work at least 10 hours per week in an on-campus position. Work study is an extremely beneficial resource for new students because it allows students to establish personal and professional connections on campus, while earning funds to contribute to their own education.

In addition to that, work study does **not negatively impact the family Adjusted Gross Income** requirement for the program. Jobs off campus could raise your Adjusted Gross Income over the limit for renewal of your status as an Emerald Eagle Scholar.

After reviewing the requirements of the program, we ask that you read and sign the Emerald Eagle Scholars Program Commitment Agreement, fill out the Mentoring Profile Sheet, and complete your Personal Statement Outline. Please return by way of:
