- All students applying to the College of Music must audition and be accepted on their major performing instrument (or voice). Auditions are held early in the spring semester for the following year's admittance. Lessons from any other school are not automatically equivalent to UNT lessons.
- All Music majors are required to pass the UNT Music Theory Proficiency and the UNT Piano Proficiency for graduation. The lower level courses in piano, aural skills and music theory at UNT are designed to prepare students directly for these examinations. Students who transfer in these courses are responsible for all content covered in UNT courses. Students may choose to repeat theory and aural skills courses if not prepared for proficiency exams.
- All Music majors also must pass a computer proficiency, and the Upper Divisional Exam and Concentration Proficiency Exam in the principal instrument or voice.

Courses Recommended for Transfer

UNT Core: English Composition & Rhetoric

This requirement will be met by fulfilling College of Music English Composition & Rhetoric requirement (see next column).

UNT Core: Discovery

One course chosen from: ARTS 1301; BIOL/HECO 1322; GEOG 1302 or 1303; HIST 2321 or 2322; PHIL 1301, 2303, or 2306; SPCH 1311 or 1315; TECA 1303

UNT Core: Mathematics

One course chosen from: MATH 1316, 1324, 1325 or 1425, 1332, 1342 or 1442, 1350, 1351, 2312 or 2412, 2313 or 2413 or 2513

UNT Core: Capstone

The Capstone Core requirement is unique to UNT and will be fulfilled by an advanced course at UNT.

UNT Core: Natural Science

This requirement will be met by fulfilling College of Music Laboratory Science requirement (see page two).

College of Music: English Composition & Rhetoric

ENGL 1301 and ENGL 1302

A grade of 'C' or better is required on courses applied toward this requirement.

UNT Core: U.S. History

Two courses chosen from: HIST 1301, 1302, 2301

College of Music: Laboratory Science

At least 6 semester hours (two courses) in laboratory sciences.

Note: All Bachelor of Music students are required to complete Science & Technology of Musical Sound (PHYS 1270) offered at UNT (no TCCNS options available); counts for Laboratory Science.

College of Music: Admission to the Major

College Admissions Requirements: Admission to the College of Music is contingent on clear admission to the University. Entering transfer students interested in majoring in Music must qualify by audition on their principal instrument or voice. Applications are due by the first Monday in December for the following Fall admission. Applications received after this date will be processed on a space available basis for the three audition dates. For additional procedures and opportunities, please contact the College of Music.

Students unable to audition in person may submit a recording representative of their performance abilities.

Transfer students will take placement examinations in piano and possibly music theory at New Student Orientation.

Special Notes

Hours Required and General/College Requirements: A minimum of 132 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements for the Bachelor of Music degree as specified in the "[General University Requirements](#)" in the [Academics](#) section of the UNT catalog and the College of Music requirements.

A minimum overall GPA (including all transferred courses) of 2.00 is required for graduation.

UNT Core Curriculum/Transfer of Core Curriculum: UNT complies with the mandates of the 1997 Texas Legislature regarding requirements for state-assisted institutions. Students who successfully complete the common core curriculum (in whole or in part) at a Texas state-assisted institution of higher education are eligible to transfer as "core complete" for those categories in the UNT University Core Curriculum.

Individual academic programs may require courses contained in parts of the University Core Curriculum. Students who wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major/program requirements simultaneously should check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.

Choice of Catalog: Any student transferring directly from a Texas public community college to UNT shall have the same choice of catalog designating degree requirements as the student would have had if the dates of attendance at the university had been the same as the dates of attendance at the community college.
